	<p><u>Sight word memory</u>: Make 2 sets of cards with all of the sight words below. Shuffle the cards and place them face down on the table. Have your child flip over a card & read the sight word (if he/she doesn't know it, tell him/her to repeat the word after you, and then turn over another card and read it. If they are a match, he/she keeps the cards and goes again. If not, he/she returns the cards to the same spot and then the parent takes a turn.</p> <p><u>Kindergarten Sight words</u>: a, am, and, are, at, can, come, dad, go, he, here, I, in, is, it, like, little, look, love, me, mom, my, no, play, said, see, she, that, the, this, to, up, was, we, went, with, yes & you</p> <p><u>Enrichment</u>: for students who already know these words, they can work on the grade one list found on our kindergarten website - datlkindergarten.weebly.com</p>

Example: instead of good, use terrific, fabulous or outstanding.
