



**DATL ONLINE LEARNING CHOICE BOARD**

<b>Word Work</b>	<p><a href="#">Mrs. Landry's Favourite</a></p> <p><b>Sight Word Stomp/ Slap</b> - Write sight words on paper (sticky notes), then place the words on the floor or walls and use a flyswatter to slap or foot to stomp the words as they are called out.</p>	<p><a href="#">Mrs. Allaby's Favourite</a></p> <p><b>Sight Word Walk</b> You will need white paper plates/paper cut into strips and a marker. Write a sight word on each of the plates/paper strip. Create a path all around the house using the paper plates/paper strips. Start at the beginning of the path and have your child read each word as she walks to the end of the path. Your child can pick up the plate/paper strip each time she reads a word. Repeat the game by creating a new path.</p>	<p><a href="#">Mrs. Kingston's Favourite</a></p> <p><b>Sight Word Towers</b> Simply write sight words on small solo cups. Students will read the word and then build a tower. They can read them again as they take it down.</p>	<p><a href="#">Mrs. Walsh's Favourite</a></p> <p><b>Playdough Sight Words</b> Roll a ball of playdough into long snakes.
